Required Material

Different requirements apply to the various sections of the magazine. The table contains **recommendations for text length**.

	What content is suitable for the News? People, facts and figures, recommended reading, useful websites and apps, interesting stories from the BACnet world – Important: articles should refer to BACnet, BIG-EU or Building Automation.

Think about the reader when writing

Write your text so that it is technically understandable and not advertising. State the **benefits of your solution** neutrally and avoid mentioning your company or product name too frequently. Do not use exaggerated attributes and superlatives. Please be sure to deliver a **high-quality translation** of each text in German and English. We recommend that new authors take a look at the last edition of BACnet Journal (www.bacnetjournal.org).

Put the spotlight on people

Quote your clients, project participants and users. It's also nice to see people on photos.

Inform the community

Take part in the news and inform us of innovations, useful, curious or interesting facts and figures from the BACnet or Building Automation world.

Approval

Since your text and images will be processed and laid out by the editors, you will receive a **proof** prior to printing as PDF for final approval.

Disclaimer

The author bears responsibility for articles which identify anyone or anything by name. This also includes release for publication by the users and project partners mentioned. As publisher the TEMAAG requires that articles be approved for publication by all companies involved in the project. For this purpose, the prior signing of a "Declaration of Copyrights and Transfer of Rights" is obligatory. Any third-party claims will be borne by the author.
